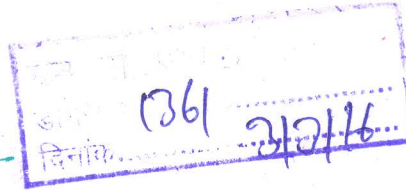

Please refer to your letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2016 regarding extension of the interim arrangement of fumigation of peas and pulses imported into India from Canada.

I am happy to inform you that Government of India has extended the interim arrangement for quarantine clearances of consignments of peas and pulses, shipped from Canada, that are duly covered by Phytosanitary certificates issued by Canadian authorities from the Phytosanitary angle for the period upto **30<sup>th</sup> September, 2016** on the condition that consignments will be fumigated by Methyl Bromide at the port of arrival in India.

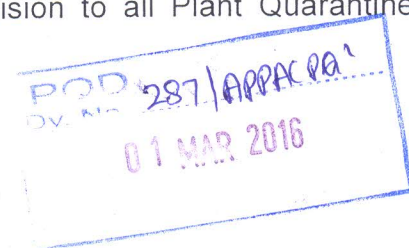
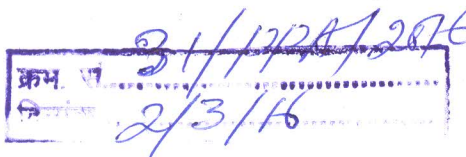
