2. I am happy to inform you that Government of India has extended the interim arrangement and permit quarantine clearances of consignments of chickpeas, peas and pulses, shipped from Canada, that are duly covered by Phytosanitary Certificates issued by Canadian authorities on the basis of fumigation by Methyl Bromide at the port of arrival in India upto **31<sup>st</sup> March, 2017**.


